<u>Focus Topic:</u> Tammy Rauch, Business Services Recruiter for the Office of Workforce Development, TCSG (Technical College System of Georgia), provided an informative presentation about the intake and tracking system currently in use for job seekers and for employers throughout Georgia. She mentioned that Georgia has just been named the Best State for Business for the tenth consecutive year.

In her role, Ms. Rauch works with new business as well as with existing businesses. She provides data for businesses that are expanding or relocating. She noted the effectiveness of the GA BEST program for teaching Soft Skills.

She emphasized the importance promoting the use of the website: www.worksourcegaportal.com
This site provides useful information and links to workforce information. Users have the option to access the site as a guest to explore various programs and services. Registration provides additional information and links. There are 40 Career Centers and 19 One-Stop Centers in Georgia.

Ms. Rauch explained that Federal Bonding is still administered by GDOL. She recommended that individuals with a record of theft, forgery, larceny, or embezzlement obtain a federal bond through GDOL prior to applying for a job. This can provide \$5,000 of insurance for an employer hiring that individual. Flyers from TCSG with information about programs related to workforce development are included in a separate email.
